ORDER

This matter, having come before the Court on Defendant's "Verified Petition for Judicial Review of Administrative License Suspension and Motion To Suppress for Violation of Defendant's 4th and 5th Amendment Rights and For Failure To Advise Her of Right Against Self Incrimination." Cause submitted. Evidence heard and submitted. The Court finds and orders as follows:

1. The defendant was not observed operating the vehicle by the police officer, and was found outside the parked car in a mulch bed, in the driveway of a home.
2. The Winfield police officer testified that he questioned the defendant, about her operation of the vehicle and her state of sobriety extensively, without having given her the Miranda Advisement and after he had decided to charge her with Operating While Intoxicated.

The Court now Grants the Defendant's Petition To Reinstate Defendant [REDACTED] Indiana Driving Privileges.

The Court further grants Defendant's Motion to Suppress All Statements Made by the Defendant to the Police Officer.

The Court finds and orders that upon the suppression of the foregoing statements there was inadequate probable cause for the Defendant to submit to a chemical test for intoxication and as such, suppresses any results for any and all chemical tests taken by the Defendant, [REDACTED] [REDACTED].
